The Pilgrimage

This is our 40th year, that the Knights of Columbus, Our Lady of Lourdes, Council 5890 from Washingtonville, NY is raising funds to send handicapped children and a parent or guardian to the Marion shrine in Lourdes, France. This year the nine young ambassadors, selected from the archdiocese of New York, will depart in June for the ten day pilgrimage as part of the 60th US National Rosary pilgrimage. All of these young ambassadors are special in the fact that they each possess a physical or mental handicap.

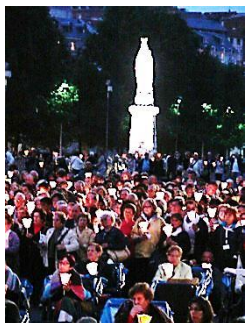


Torchlight Procession 2013

This year's pilgrimage class of pilgrims brings the total to one hundred fifty one children in forty years that the knights have sent on this once in a lifetime experience. Upon arriving in Lourdes they will join other members of the 60th U.S. National Rosary Pilgrimage where they will participate in the torchlight procession joining thousands of pilgrims from all over the world praying the rosary and singing the Ave Maria. The next day they will join in the celebration of the international mass in the underground basilica of Pope Pius X. Their days will be filled with daily masses and processions including the Eucharistic procession where the infirmed receive a special blessing. Mass at the grotto and a visit to the baths also awaits these young pilgrims as does the Stations of the Cross. A walking tour that follows the footsteps of St Bernadette from the Boly mill where she was born, to the Chacot where she lived during the apparitions to the parish church, which contains the baptismal font where she was baptized.to the old convent where she received her first Holy Communion.

History of Lourdes

In 1858 on the 11th day of February the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to a fourteen year old peasant girl named Bernadette Soubirous in a grotto carved out of the rock of Massabielle. During the third apparition on February 18th the Blessed Virgin asked young Bernadette if she would return to the grotto for fifteen days. On February 24th, the Blessed Virgin asked that Bernadette pray for sinners. A few days later on March 2nd, the Blessed Virgin asked that people come in procession and that Bernadette should ask the parish priest to build a chapel at the grotto. From the first apparition through July 16th, 1858 the Blessed Virgin presented herself to Bernadette eighteen times. That was over one hundred and fifty years ago and the tiny little town nestled in the foothills of the French Pyrenees of Lourdes, has never been quite the same.

During the third apparition the Blessed Virgin also added that she couldn't promise to make Bernadette happy in this world but in the next. This year these young ambassadors are fulfilling the request of Our Lady to go to Lourdes and pray for sinners and join in procession to the grotto. Each year over five million pilgrims descend on this small French village to pray at the grotto and bathe and drink from the spring which the Blessed Virgin revealed to Bernadette during the ninth apparition on February 25th 1858.
